CLOTHING

- 12 pair underwear
- 12 pair socks
- 1 Illahee White Uniform Shirt and Tie (ordered through camp)
- 1 Pair of white shorts/tennis skirt
- 10 Short Sleeve Shirts
- 2 Long sleeve shirts
- 10 Shorts
- 2-3 pair of jeans/pants
- 2-3 pairs of leggings/tights
- 1 red shirt & 1 blue shirt for Capture the Flag. Could be on either team.
- Modest Dance outfit (3 & 4 week)
- 2-3 one-piece bathing suits
- 2 warm sweaters, jackets, or sweatshirts
- 3-4 sets of warm pajamas
- Bathrobe or wrap towel
- 1 raincoat

SHOES

- 2-3 pair of athletic shoes
- 1 pair of closed-toe waterproof shoes/boots
- Flip flops/crocs for shower shoes
- Chacos/Tevas/or other water shoes that strap to feet for sidling rock (crocs are not a good option).

*Trips Kayakers strongly recommend Astral Kayak shoes

PLEASE DO NOT BRING

- Nice clothing items
- Personal Towels (camp provides towels)
- Any electronics (Cell Phones, Go Pros, iPods, MP3s, Kindles, smart watches, fitness trackers, Digital Cameras)
- Valuables of any sort (Jewelry, fancy makeup/skincare products)
- Twinkly Lights
- Food or Gum

Two-Week, Mini 1&2, Three, and Four Week Campers:

Items you bring to camp could get lost, stained, or ruined. Pack accordingly and leave your name brands at home! **Label everything with first and last names.**

PERSONAL ITEMS

- Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Floss
- Medications (filled by pharmacy in required Blister Packs and given to medical staff at check-in)
- Shampoo, Conditioner, and Soap (Anti-bacterial is recommended)
- Deodorant and lotion
- Brush, detangling spray, and hairbands
- Sunscreen and Chapstick
- Pump Bug Spray
- Washcloths/loofa (towels provided)
- Shower Caddy to keep items in
- Laundry Bag

MISCELLANEOUS

- Twin Sheets (2 sets) and Blanket(s)
- Pillow and 2 Pillow Cases
- Lightweight synthetic 30-degree sleeping bag
- Flashlight/headlamp w/ batteries
- Stationary and stamps
- 2 Water Bottles
- Backpack for day trips
- Books
- Hat

OPTIONAL

- Dressup Costumes/Silly Outfits (For skits. Use imagination - see back for examples)
- Sunglasses/swim goggles
- "Crazy Creek Chair" (recommended and can be ordered through camp)
- Battery Powered Clip-on fan for bunk

HELPFUL HINTS FOR PACKING AT ILLAHEE

- **We strongly encourage you to leave expensive brand-name items at home.**
- We recommend a mattress cover instead of an egg crate. If your daughter brings either for her bed, she **MUST BRING IT HOME**.
- Medication, including OTC, vitamins, and supplements, should be easily accessible in your bag so that **it can be given to our medical staff during check-in**. It must be blister-packed by a pharmacist and prescribed by a doctor.
- Shoes/boots should have been worn before camp and broken in to prevent blisters.
- Please label your camper's clothing! Laundry is organized by cabin, and the clothes are mixed together.
- If your daughter wants to bring specific items for her activities, she can, but this is **NOT REQUIRED** as we provide all needed items. (Equestrian Boots/helmet, Lacrosse Stick, Bike Helmet, Etc.)
- We often dance with a local boys' camp during the June and July sessions. Girls are welcome to bring a nicer outfit, but wearing a T-shirt is also fine!
- We recommend that some of your clothing be synthetic rather than cotton to help dry out quicker.
- Camp is an opportunity to embrace a simpler routine. We encourage you to leave excessive skin, hair, and body care products at home.
- The climate at camp is cooler in the mornings/evenings and warm in the afternoons. We get rain showers most days. Be sure to pack the warmer clothing items and rain gear listed.
